

30-Day Facility Rollout Handout

A leave-behind plan for facilities evaluating Lantern Academy training.

Goal

Help a facility team start medical gas technician training in a focused 30-day window without interrupting daily operations. Keep the rollout small, visible, and easy to document.

Distributor follow-up: offer to introduce the facility to Lantern for pricing, setup guidance, or a short implementation call.

01 WEEK

PICK THE TEAM

- Name one internal owner for enrollment, reminders, and completion tracking.
- Choose the first technician group or pilot location.
- Identify current medical gas pain points: outlets, alarms, oxygen, vacuum, manifolds, or permit-to-work process.

02 WEEK

START WITH FREE PROOF

- Watch the free course demo and one repair video as a team.
- Agree on what success looks like: better vocabulary, repair confidence, cleaner handoffs, or clearer documentation.
- Confirm which leaders need visibility into training progress.

03 WEEK

LAUNCH THE TRAINING PATH

- Enroll the pilot group and schedule weekly completion checkpoints.
- Tie lessons to equipment the team actually touches.
- Capture questions for the facility leader, RFA, or vendor partner.

04 WEEK

REVIEW AND EXPAND

- Review completions, stuck points, and confidence changes.
- Decide whether to expand by site, shift, or equipment responsibility.
- Save certificates and notes with the facility training records.
